**Founded:** First hospital established in 1912; current facility opened in 2004

**Organizational Structure:** Charitable, not-for-profit, community-owned hospital; Member of Parkview Health since 2000

**Size/Campus:** 115,000-square-foot facility, sitting on a 66-acre campus that includes a  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile health walk and meditation garden

**Beds:** 31

**Medical Staff Members:** 450 active and affiliate physicians; 80 allied health professionals

## SERVICES

**Emergency Department:** full-service, 24-hour emergency department with 12 treatment rooms, three trauma bays and five other specialized treatment rooms

**Constant Care:** Medical/Surgical/Progressive Care 26 bed unit with telehealth capabilities for specialty care

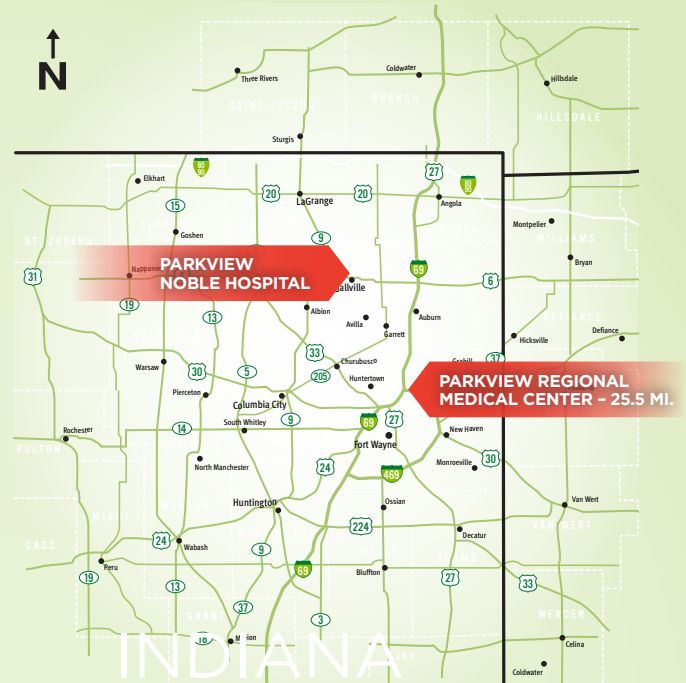
**Surgery:** three surgical suites; nine outpatient surgery rooms, infusions and other ambulatory services

**Endoscopy Center:** two endoscopy suites, GI physician clinic and recovery area

**Family Birthing Center:** two labor-delivery-recovery rooms, two ante-partum rooms and five postpartum rooms; breastfeeding support and birth planner services available

**Rehabilitation Services:** inpatient and outpatient physical, occupational and speech therapy for adults and children; newly-expanded cardiac and pulmonary rehab

**Diagnostic Services:** 3-D digital mammography, 3-D and 4-D ultrasound, nuclear medicine, CT, MRI, HeartSmart CT, bone density scans and on-site laboratory services



**Specialty Medical Services:** houses cardiology, orthopedics, neurology, wound care, pain management, pulmonary and more

**EMS:** Parkview Noble Hospital, in partnership with Noble County, operates the emergency ambulance services for all areas of Noble County

**Sleep Disorders Lab:** diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders

**Center for Wound Healing:** provides the latest in clinically-proven treatments, including two hyperbaric chambers for all types of hard-to-heal wounds

**Center for Healthy Living:** offers a variety of nutritional lectures and demos, as well as support groups and educational and healing arts programs in partnership with other community organizations. A variety of free and reduced cost screenings are also available.

**Parkview Physicians Group:** primary care services on the hospital campus and in several locations in Noble County
